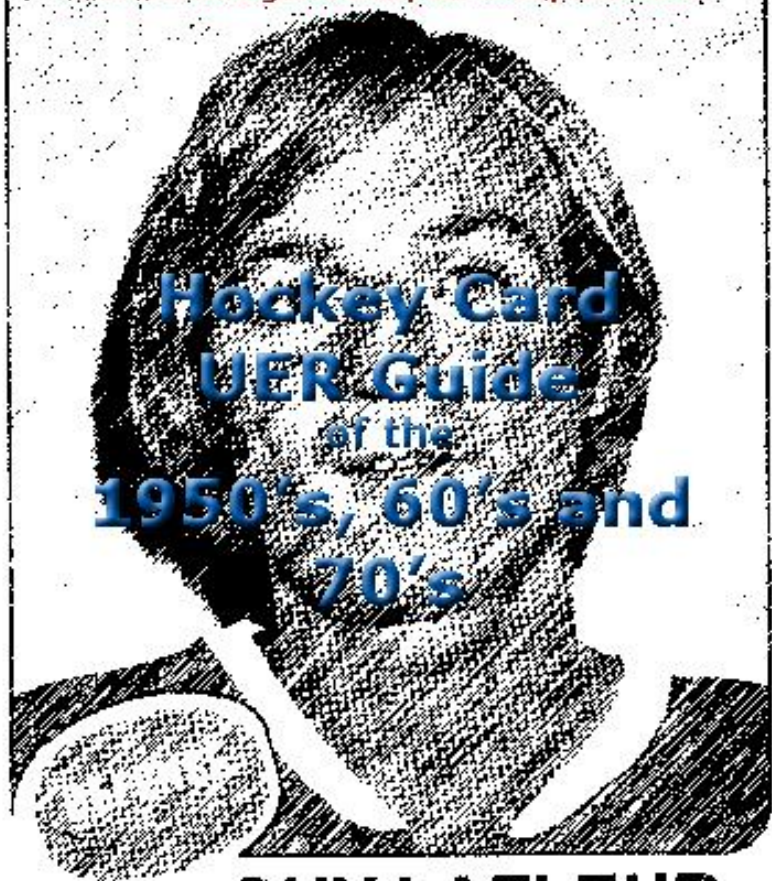

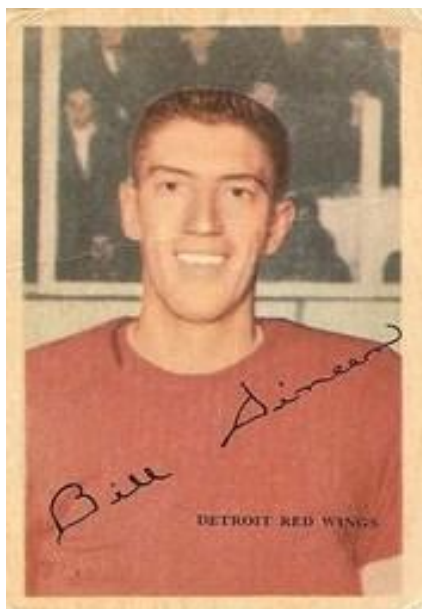

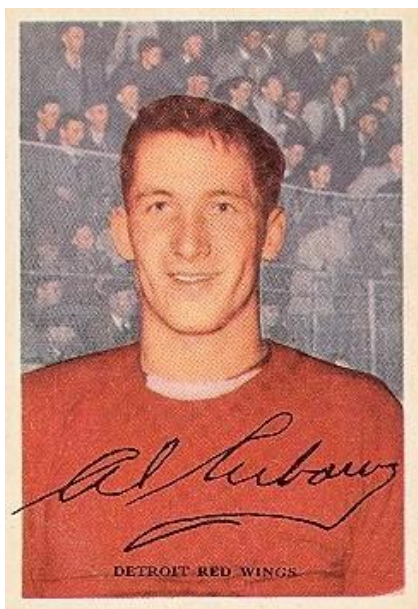

His goals-against average of 2.60 is the lowest for a Ranger goaltender since 1940-41 when Davey Kerr chalked up the same mark. Bowers was a contender for both the Hart trophy and Rookie award last season. He was a restaurant manager last summer at a resort near Prince Albert.
